**Remarks:** *Cleonus albicelus* Schaitter, 1870 was often listed as a synonym of *Bothynoderes declivis* (Olivier, 1807), but it is a nomen nudum, published in a checklist but never described. However, considering that *B. declivis* was never cited for Poland, it is more likely that it refers to *B. affinis* (and it may indeed be an error for *C. albodus*).
